Sun 8 Oct 8.45am	<b>Six Mosses Walk (Led by Bob Charlesworth)</b>  This 12+ mile walk takes in many of the mosses in our area.

Sun 12 Nov 10.00am	<b>Walk of Remembrance (Led by Baz Fewster)</b>  Local walk incorporating a 10-minute, al fresco, secular service of Remembrance.
Sat 25 Nov 1.30pm	<b>Cuddington Loop (Led by Helen Connolly)</b>  Taking in Dymocks Mill which straddles the English-Welsh border. From Sherry Mill Hill, drive and meet walk leader at Jarrett's Barn, Cuddington (Grid Ref: SJ4515746860)
Sun 10 Dec 10.00am	<b>Congleton Edge Loop (Led by Clive &amp; Jane Bullock)</b>  Following Congleton Edge, this walk enjoys spectacular views across the Cheshire plain. From Sherry Mill Hill, drive and meet leaders at 11am at Ackers crossing (Grid: SJ846588)
Sat 16 Dec 1.00pm	<b>Whitchurch Walkers Christmas Meal</b>  at The Castle at Bletchley. Details and menu will be sent to members.
Mon 01 Jan 10.00pm	<b>New Year's Revolution: Mere &amp; Moss (Led by Baz Fewster)</b>  A 5-mile brisk bumble to blow away the tinsel. Followed by soup and sandwiches (£5pp) at The Old Town Hall Vaults. <b>Cars not needed.</b>
Sun 14 Jan 10.00am	<b>The Wrekin (Led by Malcolm Monie)</b>  This Wrekin walk includes Little Hill, Maddock's Hill and the Ercall quarries [Shropshire Wildlife Trust reserve].
Sat 27 Jan 12.30pm	<b>Farndon &amp; Holt (Led by Baz Fewster)</b>

	A return visit to walk this area of the Dee valley and check on the progress at Holt castle.
<b>Sun 11 Feb 10.00am</b>	<b>Coalbrookdale &amp; Ironbridge Gorge (Led by Kevin Ikin)</b> This mixed walk of woodland and roads takes in some fine views from the high points.
<b>Sat 24 Feb 1.30pm</b>	<b>Nantwich West (Led by Jean White &amp; Dot Bishop)</b> Park at Acton and use rights of way/tow path to Ravensmoor, Swanley and Nantwich Marina.
<b>Sun 11 Mar 10.00am</b>	<b>Oswald's Trail, Oswestry (Led by Liz Evans)</b> The trail is a circuit of Oswestry taking in many historical points of interest. From Sherry Mill Hill, drive and meet leader at Central car park, Oswestry at 10.00am
<b>Sat 24 Mar 1.30pm</b>	<b>Peckforton Hill area (Led by Alan Howe &amp; Christine Patterson)</b> A dog-friendly 5-mile walk, avoiding stiles, along quiet lanes and paths. The route will involve a call at the Pheasant Inn, a dog friendly hostelry!
<b>Tue 3 April 7.30pm</b>	<b>Annual General Meeting at the Archibald Worthington Club, Whitchurch</b> Meeting followed by buffet and entertainment

**NOTES:**

1. The meeting point for all walks is Sherry Mill Hill car park, unless otherwise stated.
2. Saturday walks will be 5 or 6 miles, Sunday walks between 8 and 10 miles. However, both may be subject to change depending upon weather, walking conditions and unforeseen circumstances.
3. Leaders will be pleased to give details of any walks.
4. All members are expected to observe the Country Code.
5. Dogs are permitted on walks but **MUST** be restrained on a lead at the leader's request and **ALWAYS** when in fields containing livestock.
6. In all matters relating to any walk, the leader's decision is final.
7. Junior members are welcome, but aged fourteen and under must be accompanied by an adult.
8. Members are reminded that they are on walks entirely at their own risk.
9. On Sunday walks, bring packed lunch and – unless a pub stop is indicated – a drink.
10. Please wear suitable footwear – fields are often very muddy.

11. Please bring your car if available for all “away from home” walks.
12. The cost of transport for “away from home” walks should be shared by members at a rate of 15 per mile per car. Drivers are encouraged to accept this amount or donate to club funds.
13. Members are requested not to walk in front of the leader.
14. People with a known medical condition should be aware that group leaders may have a basic First Aid knowledge but cannot take responsibility for existing medical conditions.
